



01 Basics of Copyright Protection in China

Scope of copyright protection



- Creative works: designs, posters, brochures, photographs, drawings,
 videos, computer software, models, websites, articles.
- Industrial designs: industrial and graphic designs, applied art, architectural building.

Industrial design: patent or copyright protection?



- If your design patent has not been granted in China;
- The design patent is ceased;
- If your design has lost the novelty.
- Register both rights.





01 Basics of Copyright Protection in China

Why to register copyright?



- Automatic protection 178 countries of Berne Convention
- Notice and take-down procedures of e-commerce platforms
- Formality examination, fast, cheap
- No need of a lawyer/agent
- Protection terms: 50 years
- Prima facie evidence
- Enforcement requirement





How to Register Copyright with Copyright Protection Centre of China (CPCC)

User account creation

Online application with doc. and info.

Submission by mail

Certificate issuance

Time



1 month

Costs



40 Euro for one works





How to register copyright with the CPCG - Required documents

- 1. Documents of identification
- 2. Sample of the works
- 3. Commitment of the work registration
- 4. Claims on the ownership of the works

- 1. Documents of identification
- ✓ <u>Company</u>: business certificate and the Chinese translation is required.
- ✓ <u>Individual</u>: scanned copy of the individual passport, the Chinese translation.
- ✓ <u>IP agency</u>: Power of Attorney.





How to register copyright with the CPCC - Required information in Chinese

- Who created the work?
- When and where was the work created?
- When and where was the work first published?
- **Why** was the work created?


- **How** was the work created? (creation process, i.e. a brief introduction on how the works were created?)
- What special features does the work have, that make it distinctive from others' works? (originality and creativity)





Copyright enforcement actions - Different options

O3 Copyright enforcement actions

3.2

Evidence collection

- Ownership: certificate; drafts, sketches and dated copies of your work; first use and publication evidence.
- Use evidence of the owner: sales, marketing, media report, etc.
- Infringement evidence: contracts, photographs of infringing products and proof of sale.

3.3

Evidence preservation

- Notarisation
- Blockchain





O3 Copyright enforcement actions



Advantage of blockchain notarisation

- Notarise the electronic evidence any time anywhere
- Without hiring a lawyer or a notary public
- > Cheap

Notice and take-down procedure

- Easy and fast
- Original photos and videos,
 without the certificate

3.5

Judicial actions

- Statutory damages:RMB 500-5,000,000
- Online copyright infringement:Internet courts





04 Take-away messages



- ✓ Though copyright is automatically granted, you should register it in China before someone else does.
- ✓ If your industrial design can not be protected as a patent, you can consider copyright registration.



- ✓ Keep drafts, sketches and dated copies of your work as proof of copyright.
- ✓ For online copyright evidence, you can use blockchain to preserve the evidence on your own.


